The Bunurong (Boonerwung) people are the Indigenous people from the Western Port area

Quick facts

- Bunurong people are part of the Kulin Nation
- Birds' eggs, fish and shellfish provide food
- Scar trees, shell middens, stone tools and artefacts are reminders of this sustainable culture

What you can do

- Acknowledge that you are on the land of the Traditional Owners at events
- Contact the City of Casey to find out what Aboriginal sites are protected and if permits are required
- Make friends with Aboriginal people and hear their stories
